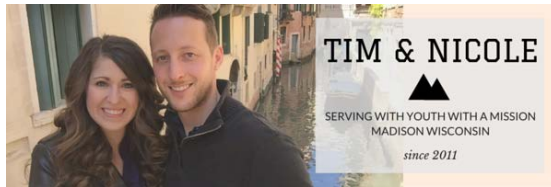


YWAM - Madison
