Our introduction in China was a success! We have 8 relatively well-educated leaders asking for our first workshop in April. I was assured more are eager to join the core training group. They took to the preview training immediately. Most of the questions were about multiplying the training. The small churches are relatively autonomous and disconnected for good reasons, so we spent some time on their questions to overcome that issue. There is always resistance to careful Bible study and preaching to be multiplied, no matter the culture. We are trusting God the Spirit to provide the power and wisdom the movement needs. Really, that is where we always end up. It is a God thing or nothing.

Our Manila and Cebu City trainings had problems, but God helped the group in Cebu do better organizing and in Manila, I overcame the flu. A man named Jesus wants to train on his island, Cabulan. The other pastors told him he could not begin until he goes back and attends a Jonah training, which he missed. A new training is starting on Leyte island, so he plans to attend the Jonah Workshop there. I'm so thankful for their spirit. Another man, Gregorio, has started a dozen neighborhood outreach Bible studies. He credits Pathway trainings with helping him believe he could help others understand the Bible. The studies are hosted by one family and the neighbors are so close they come out to see what is going on and join in. There is a "ripple effect" we never thought of!

A highlight of this trip is that JoHannah and I were able to visit with our son Jason and his family, who live in the Philippines. It doesn't hurt that it was in the 80s when home was getting 6 inches of snow!
