4. Read 2 Chronicles 14:9-11. How was King Asa's response similar to that of Jehoshaphat?

What was the prophet Azariah's message to King Asa in 15:2? Why is the timing of the prophet's message surprising?

How did King Asa respond to the prophet's message? (See verses 8-15)

What danger did King Asa eventually succumb to in 16:7-12?

5. Write a few statements that you would put under the title, "How to be successful in a ministry".

6. What ministry has God called you to right now? How would you apply those principles?
