figure out what is wrong with him. Recently he was in the hospital again and his platelets and hemoglobin were alarmingly low. He received more blood transfusions. We

love this family and are once again asking for prayer. Please pray that the doctors will be able to accurately diagnose his condition.

Our house feels rather empty at the moment. Since last summer we have had a steady stream of people staying with us. We have often wondered if we would enjoy running a guest house and I think perhaps we would. This is all possible greatly due to the fact that we have wonderful, long-term helpers who keep things running.

One of my main jobs at Faith is to help keep Steve afloat! We have shared an office for over 25 years and for the most part have figured out how to work together and complement one another. As we said in our last prayer letter, Steve has put on the Deputy Head of School hat again for this second semester. Currently our Head of School is out of the country so Steve is OIC and that is always especially stressful.

We look forward to a very special summer as we return to the US for our son's wedding, Steve's mother's 90th birthday celebration, and three Faith alumni reunions. The weeks will fly by I'm sure.
