1. Why did Jesus have to come down to earth? What was His purpose? (Matthew 1:21)
2. Read Matthew 4:1-11 Jesus is face to face with the enemy, and is attacked with three temptations. List the three temptations that Satan threw at Jesus.
3. Jesus overcame each temptation the same way. How did he make Satan run?
4. How can God's Word help us overcome temptation in our daily lives?  
Share a personal example where you used God's Word to overcome temptation.
5. Read Psalm 119:9-11
  - How can a young man or woman keep his way pure?
  - God has given us a road map to get to heaven. He has given us solutions to all our problems. When we are faced with a tough choice where should we go for the answer?
6. Read Philippians 4:8
  - Our thoughts have a direct impact on our actions. Would you describe your daily thoughts as good or bad?
