Another lady from our staff was able to go to Costa Rica to teach and provide training in several venues to those who want to learn, go, and serve the Lord.

I am grateful to be able to use the abilities God has given me to serve my co-workers. As we each do our part, together we work to bring the Kingdom of God to those who yet need to hear the gospel message. Thank you for your kind support enabling me to do my part.
