Is it a reward the believer experiences in this life, or after death? Try to describe it.

5. Read the lost sheep parable of Jesus in Luke 15:1-7. What is the point of the parable?

What should be a great joy in your life? Is it? Why, or why not?

6. What is the main application of this study, and/or the sermon and its passages, for you?
