The theme will be "Breaking Trails" A Study in the Book of Acts.

He has been putting his own Home Visitation Ministry together and uses the handout material that our Fellowship provides to its fullest. It was his recent suggestion that we stock up on a few different Gospel Tracks in addition to the current material. His village corporation and Athna as a whole have been seeking to involve him more in leadership roles.

Other prayer requests would be for our Single Moms Ministry and for a few "fringe" couples we have been reaching out to and focusing on. The Christmas/Holiday Season oddly enough, made it harder to connect with most of these folks. We'd like to establish more consistent contact and ministry with them. Praise the Lord after 209 days in NICU, little Sophie (my nephew's premature daughter) is at home! As you can imagine, Ben and Sarah are happy parents. Their need now is for home nursing help.

A few more family news items to share are: Caleb and Hannah have given us another grandson! Praise God for healthy mom and baby! And our eldest son Joshua, has been promoted to Sergeant with the Alaska State Troopers! As such, they desire to give him his own Post so he will be relocating to Cordova, Alaska to take on that responsibility.
