Greetings from the frozen tundra of Red Deer...

Thanks so much for your continued prayers. My health is going through one issue after another. The anemia is being controlled with transfusions. Recently I saw my gastroenterologist who is pleased that my weight has improved but is still very concerned with my blood loss. They have contemplated a procedure where the patient swallows a pill-size camera which takes photos of the inside of the small bowel. However, due to my many adhesions the danger of having the camera get lodged in my gut, disqualifies me from that procedure. I am just thankful that I do continue to respond well to the blood transfusions.

Two weeks ago, I had a sudden onset of severe pain and swelling in my right leg. At first, they thought it was a deep venal thrombosis (blood clot). Two days ago, they did an ultrasound which showed no blood clots but a large fluid-filled Bakers Cyst. Now, I am waiting for an appointment with a radiologist to drain the cyst and address the pain with cortisone. It has been a tough time needless to say, with pain and many doctor visits. I need to keep my leg elevated and use crutches to get around. Please do pray for me that the Lord would give me healing and the ability to be mobile.

I am continuing to write my story and keep up with my ministry through correspondence with the Russian-speaking ladies. Roman continues his teaching ministry and I have a long-distance relationship counseling many of the student wives.

Roman went to Minsk Belarus on Feb 23, and just came home March 2. Pray that he would stay strong physically. He came back from Kazakhstan with a terrible cold and still has a cough. Recently, while juggling his backpack and computer his laptop computer slipped and hit the icy ground. He had to deal with a broken laptop and trying to save his teaching notes! He needed to get a new laptop to transfer his materials.

Thanks so very, very much for your prayers...please do keep my health in prayer.
