

# Oscar & Karla Chiquitó Commission to Every Nation Impacting Guatemala Network – IGN

On February 21st Karla had a tonsil surgery. The recovery process took longer than expected. Emily, then, got a virus in her lungs and Karla got the same virus later. The week after, Oscar got a very bad flu & cold and lost his voice for a few days. These last 30 days were challenging for the Chiquitos, but Praise God for the support and prayers of family and friends. The Chiquitó family is now back to their normal life.

IGN and Woodlands Church in Plover, WI had the blessing to serve a group of 30 churches in the state of Jalapa (eastern Guatemala) through a 4-day medical clinic with the purpose of evangelism. The gospel was shared to more than 1,200 people and 79 of them were born again, Praise God! IGN started a 7-month training program to help the Jalapa Association of Pastors so their congregations can become intentional about discipleship. The goal for August 2019 is that each of the 30 churches will have a strategic plan focused on discipleship.

In February, IGN started a 5-year leadership plan to train 35 pastors from the Voice of God Denomination. The trainings are bimonthly and the goal is to empower ministry leaders so they can lead the church's plan on making disciples. The topic for February was the Characteristics of a True Disciple of Christ (Part 1).

IGN and the Pathway Training team Implemented the 7th Bible training/workshop to a group of 11 pastors that are multiplying the training to another 70 pastors from the Mundial Extendido Denomination. This 3-day workshop was based on the book of Romans.

March 4th was the beginning of the water well project. This project will provide water to the future building of the Retreat & Training Center for Pastors. Praise God for His provision!
