Following when it Doesn't Make Sense

God's call and mission for me is to *fully trust* and *obey* Him!

I. The Times of the Call (12:1-9)

Abraham's call included promises of <u>blessings</u> and <u>provision</u>, but required him to <u>trust God</u> and <u>act</u>!

II. The Covenant of the Call (15:1-12)

Obeying God's call brought Abraham to the point that he had to move from *relying* on *him*, to *relying* on *God*.

III. The Test of the Call (22:1-18)

Abraham's call was tested to prove that he <u>trusted God</u> enough to <u>not withhold anything</u> from Him.

- 4. Read Luke 18:9-14 & Isaiah 31:1. What is the misplaced trust in, and for, in these verses?

What are some of the things, other than God, that people trust in today?

How would you explain both carrying out your responsibility <u>and</u> trusting God to a new believer?

Is there something that you're trusting in more than God? What makes it hard to put your trust in God? How can you begin to work on trusting God?
