What did Paul say in Colossians 1:29 that he experienced? For what purpose?

What did Paul want his readers to believe in Ephesians 3:20? Read a little before and after this verse. What purpose of Paul is revealed?

Is there an "impossible" thing you're ready to step out and do, trusting God?
