

In our church, as well as in our sister churches, there have been a number of people who had seriously fallen or had some fatal decease who are now totally healed or have recovered enough to be able to carry on their lives. We praise God for this wonderful answer of prayer. One man who had cancer so bad we thought that he would die in the next month or so is now coming to church and testifying of all God has done for him.

Once again, I thank you so much for all your prayers and gifts towards my ministry here in France. May God's richest blessings be yours.
