I love the Old Testament. It takes a little more time to sift through than the New Testament but the jewels scattered throughout are so valuable to knowing God better and continuing spiritual growth. Here's an example. The first chapter of Judges lists the failure of several tribes to finish-

ing driving the inhabitants out of their inherited land. Chapter 2 begins with a rebuke for that from the angel of the Lord. Verse 7 says, "The people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who survived Joshua, who had seen all the great work of the LORD which He had done for Israel. (*Judges 2:7, NASB*). The account continues, Joshua died and was buried (v. 8-9). Then, "All that generation also were gathered to their fathers; and there arose another generation after them who did not know the LORD, nor yet the work which He had done for Israel. ¹¹ Then the sons of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD and served the Baals, ¹² and they forsook the LORD, the God of their fathers, who had brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods from *among* the gods of the peoples who were around them, and bowed themselves down to them; thus they provoked the LORD to an-ger." (*Judges 2:10-12*).

Here's the tragedy, the knowledge of God and works of God were not passed on to the next generation. The generation of Joshua and Caleb died in the wilderness for their unbelief. The next generation took the Promised Land under Joshua's leadership. They saw God's provision in the wilderness and in the series of victories that gave them control of the land. They obeyed the Lord, but they failed to convey to their children what they had experienced of what the Lord had done. And the result, a generation "who did not know the LORD, nor yet the work which He had done for Israel" (v. 10).

Reading this account in my quiet time recently left me asking myself these questions, "Have I, do I, tell my children and grandchildren what I have seen God do? Do I tell them what it is like to know God?" This account made me wonder if it isn't this exact same failure that is taking place today, a younger generation walking away from the faith, the church, and the Lord, because they haven't heard compelling testimony from their parents and that generation. Have they left it to the church and youth pastors? Children and teenagers need to hear testimony from their parents. And testimony that is reinforced by grandparents, aunts and uncles, and other Christian adults serve to combat against the multitude of forces pulling young people away from the Lord.

We have adopted the statement, "*Building Families*" in our vision statement. We have hired Pastor Troy to be our Family Ministries Pastor to help parents, and all of us, in spiritual formation of our children. But ultimately, it comes down to us as believing parents, grandparents, and young adults. We have to give testimony!

Last week I heard the host of a program on Christian radio tell of how he remembered his grandmother reading the Bible to him. She would bring each of her grandchildren up on her lap from the time they were little tikes. He attributed much of where he is today to the foundation she helped lay in his life. Every one of her 17 grandchildren are walking with the Lord today.

We have got to be people who give personal testimony to knowing God, of the work of God, and who open God's Word with conviction, to the next generation. The risk of what the consequences might be is too great to fall down on this. Today is the day to pick up the mantle. Are you in?


FICTION – The love of Christ


MARRIAGE – The later years of love *Married And Still Loving It: The Joys and Challenges of the Second Half* by Gary Chapman and Harold Myra
