In January Tracy took hardbound ESV Global Study Bibles for classroom use during the three-year course, ones which will be taken home by the pastors upon completion of the program. This latest resource will be for their immediate personal use in ministry, one they will be extremely excited about!

The Reformation Study Bible has an amazing amount of theological and Bible background material, as well as commentary on the text. Along with the Bibles, they will receive a commentary by R.C. Sproul on the book of Ephesians. This NT epistle is the primary focus of exegesis and preaching for the first year of APC. During this most recent trip Tracy will be meeting individually with the 21 APC pastors to review their exegesis of an assigned passage in Ephesians. In September, each pastor will be preaching on his assigned passage for their first homiletics (preaching) course.



Tracy and Tyler flew out of O'Hare for Zambia via Dubai and arrived May 23rd. The Doctrine of Scripture class was taught May 28 - June 8, two weeks of intense lecturing and learning. For many of the pastors, this was their first time to think deeply and biblically about what it means for the Bible to be the Word of God.
