It is very hard for us to believe all of the changes that have happened in our lives in the last couple of months. In July we learned that we were needing to stay in the US for a number of weeks longer in order for Rhonda's eve to heal from a corneal ulcer. I had gotten cortisone shots in both of my knees and we were hoping that this would keep the pain at a tolerable level for a while. The plan was to go back to the Philippines this month. Things have changed. Rhonda went back to her eye doctor. He's a wonderful Christian man who attends one of our supporting churches, knows us and our ministry, and is well-renowned for his work as an ophthalmologist. He has traveled to Asia many times in this capacity and has visited Manila as well. During this exam the good news was that the ulcer on her cornea had healed up, however, her eyes were not responding as well as they should to treatment. The severity of her dry eye condition makes it very possible that another ulcer could occur. Then came these unexpected words, "You seriously need to consider not going back to Manila." At first, she thought he meant only this year, but then realized he meant not to go back at all, even to pack! It didn't take either of us long to realize that we had to take this very seriously and after praying and talking for a couple of days, we knew that this was exactly what we had to do - leave the country and people we have loved for the past 34 years. For some time now, we have been praying that the Lord would make it very clear when it was time for us to go back to the US. Though a difficult decision, we both have that surpassing peace about it that comes only from God.

I will return to Manila in January and February to pack. I'm waiting until January because shortly after having the cortisone shots in my knees, I twisted my right knee and the pain returned. The decision was made to have right knee replacement September 7th. Due to my auto-immune condition I have very low platelets, so we also had to go to a hematologist. I was put on massive doses of steroids to boost them so I could have the surgery. The current plan is to go to Manila in January and February and then come back for left knee replacement surgery in March. We'll then be travelling to all of our churches and our supporters to say thank you and goodbye. We will officially end our time with FEBC in December 2019.

As you can imagine, we have very mixed feelings right now and are going through quite a bit of grieving and transition. Although we had been anticipating that our time at Faith was soon coming to an end, we were not expecting it to be in this dramatic of a way. However, we are thrilled to be close to family again. In the midst of sadness there is intense joy as we welcomed a new granddaughter into the family in August. During all of this we have been in awe of the Lord's provision and amazing orchestration of events. We look forward to sharing more with you about how God has done "abundantly more than we could ever ask or think".
