These have been busy months. Our time at Jatapuzinho this summer was filled with opportunities for discipleship and working on the dictionary and Bible courses. Our time was cut short when Charles' father passed away in July. Charles went to his hometown of Guaratingueta, São Paulo, to spend several weeks with his 89-year-old mother. He was able to help secure a caregiver for her. We had hoped that she would be able to come and spend various months with us, but she is too frail to travel. The Lord provided an excellent caregiver, and we are grateful. Charles' mom suffered with pneumonia in August and we were very concerned, but she is recovering well.

Also, in August Charles and six Wai Wai men worked for 45 hours one week on the revision of the gospel of Mark. The week was very intensive and they were able to work through the first seven chapters of Mark. These men returned to Boa Vista in September and the group will work together until the book of Mark is completed. The first chapters have already been distributed for the purpose of reading for readability and understanding. It has been encouraging to see the growth and dedication on the part of these men participating in the revision project.

Julie continues her work as mission hostess. At the moment there are fewer missionaries on base, so she is able to get ahead on maintenance projects, weeding, and extra cleaning. The calendar for guests coming and going in October through December is very full.
