An Old "Church Growth" Model

The church is built through the labors and sufferings of its people. (1:24-25, 29; 2:1)

The church is built through a growing knowledge of "Christ in me" in its people. (1:26-28; 2:2, 5)

A growing church is the believer's joy! (1:24; 2:5)
