- 4. What responsibility is given fathers, and mothers (implied by context), for raising children in Ephesians 6:4?

What are some of the challenges to fulfilling this responsibility? What are some helpful practices?

5. From Ephesians 6:5-9, what is the responsibility of the employee, and of the boss in the workplace? What is to be the motivation?

What should a Christian employee do if his Christian boss is treating his employees poorly? What should the Christian boss do if his Christian employee is lazy and/or doing shoddy work?
