Staying out of jail is a good thing. However, after arriving in Zambia this past February, new immigration regulations created that possibility for Tracy. There were fines, and initially, limitations put on his stay. Thankfully, God answered prayers and cleared the way for his new work permit to be approved and his stay extended! Zambia, like many nations, is changing and tightening immigration laws, but getting the right information can be challenging.

For two weeks, Tracy and three Zambian partners taught a course on Christian doctrine. One of the topics was sin and grace. Emile, Frederick, Cassius, and Tracy were able to speak directly about the prosperity gospel. The pastors were also introduced to Augustine, a north African. Many Zambians believe they can lose their salvation. This course lays a foundation for helping them to see this issue differently. Another topic covered during the course was the Trinity. This is especially relevant because of the large influence of Jehovah's Witnesses in Zambia. Athanasius, a third century North African, championed the Biblical Trinity. Zambians have some of the same questions as we do about the Trinity—for instance, how can Jesus be fully God and fully man? There is a bent in Zambia towards believing He knows all things, so He must be faking it when he says only the Father knows the time of His return. Together the class explored some of the mysteries of our Lord's glorious person. In addition to Athanasius and Augustine, the APC pastors were introduced to Anselm. Most of us do not realize the thanks we owe this Italian. Anselm pointed the Church in the direction of understanding that the atonement does not primarily refer to a payment owed to the Devil, but as a debt owed to God. Realizing that two of the above Church Fathers were from Africa, filled the pastors with thankfulness for their heritage. They learned how Africans shaped the Church's understanding and defended the truth.

A faithful and diligent student, Apson Musonda missed two days the first week of class in February. His beautiful singing voice, which often led the class in worship, was also missed as he was in and out of the hospital during the second week. Only one day after the course was completed, Apson was diagnosed with liver cancer and passed away three days later. Privileged to be with him during his final hour, Tracy and Frederick Bwalya read Scripture and prayed for him as he lay unconscious. They also consoled and helped his wife and extended family. Apson is sorely missed. Please pray for his widow's faith to be strengthened, they had only been married a few months.

In May, Kelly Dehnert and Shawn Young traveled with Tracy to help teach in APC. Both of these men have lived a number of years in Africa and looked forward to reconnecting with Africans. The lectures in May focused on leadership, a subject dear to Kelly's heart.
