Lukewarm?

Jesus said some pretty harsh words to a church in Revelation 3. He was speaking to the church in Laodicea (*Revelation 3:14-22*) and pointing out that their richness and thinking they don't need anything was the cause of their lukewarm Christian lives. He said, "I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth." (*Revelation 3:15-16, NASB*). Jesus said this to a church!



Someone recently said to me, "Our Hispanic congregation puts us to shame." We were talking about the joint baptism and the enthusiasm so many of them have about knowing Christ. I had mentioned that they had 23 people at prayer meeting a week ago. The leaders of Iglesia Biblica Evagélica had also told me that their people want to meet more often; that back home there are meetings at church almost every day of the week! To that I thought, "It may be in part to the fact that they don't have much materially." Too much stuff, and too many things to do, certainly has the potential to choke the ministry of God's Word in us. Jesus told us so in the parable of the soils (*Matthew 13:3-9, 18-23*).

These brothers and sisters inspire me, which is what I think my friend meant. The IBE leaders asked me for a recommendation of discipleship material that they can use. I have to work on the answer to that a little yet. They understand the purpose of the church and every believer – to make disciples (*Matthew 28:19-20*). Their question raises the question, "What discipleship material do we use?" It also raises the question, "How do we disciple people?" The short answer is, our Life Groups are our primary means of discipling people. The reason is because of the need for Biblical intake combined with personal relationships.

Nine couples and one individual, young adult to retired senior, have gone through the "Uncommon Leadership 101" training material with me in preparation for a revamping of our Life Groups. Our goal is to be intentional about making disciples. This is truly a God-sized task! For some, who are at the beginning of learning what it means to follow Jesus, it will be getting established in some basic truths. For long-time followers, it may be reigniting a walk that's lost some of its enthusiasm. For others, it may be working through some hurts or hang-ups. The trained leaders are equipped with some "tools" and will participate in ongoing training to help them continue to grow in their leadership skills. We recognize that Biblical content, authentic relationships, and the Holy Spirit's work are the key ingredients.

Our groups will begin the week of September 8th. Sign up is online at our church website, monroebiblechurch.org, or by personally contacting a leader. Groups will remain open to newcomers all year, and if a group is not a good fit, people are free to try another group. Groups will follow the study guides on the back of the Sunday sermon notes, and have the freedom to do another (approved) study of their choice for up to 12 weeks of the calendar year. Groups will be more than Bible studies. They will also include times of prayer, encouragement in personal growth, and occasional activities outside of the weekly group meeting to help put "wheels" to our faith.

A young mom was recently telling me how hard it is to choose which activities their children should be involved in, and the criteria they were using. I was encouraged when she said that building their children's faith was central, learning lifelong activities (as opposed to strictly youthful), and interaction with those yet-to-believe, was important. Committing too much time, thought, and money to non-important activities can become a choking force, and render me lukewarm, if not cold, in my spiritual life.

How about you, and your family? Can you move "making disciples" to the top of your priority list? I think that if we do, and as we work at it, we'll find ourselves growing, and our spiritual fervor growing hotter!



Pathways Pastors to Graduate

Pastor Dan will be headed back to Guatemala October 13-18 as a Pathways trainer. This will be the ninth and final workshop for this group of pastor-trainers. He will be with the Latin America Director Mike Gunderson. They launched the training together three years ago and are looking forward to a graduation celebration with them at the end of the training. Pastor Dan will have trained this group twice each year of their training. These pastors use the material and format they learn to train other pastors in their district after they return home. Oscar Chiquito, our contact says the training is definitely having a positive impact in these pastors' ministries. Keep Pastor Dan in your prayers!

Pathways is part of the Evangelical Free Church's mission organization called Reach Global. It is a three-year, three-times-per-year program designed to train pastors to accurately understand and teach the Word of God. Pathways takes this training to pastors who generally don't have access to seminary training, and who will train other pastors.

2020 Guatemala Playground Mission Trip

It's already time to start planning for next year's short-term mission trip! A team will be going to Guatemala from July 18-25, 2020 to install a refurbished playground at a church in Aldea Los Gonzalez, Montana Xalapan, Jalapa, Guatemala under the guidance of the *Kids Around the World* Staff.

To be considered for the 2020 team, 5 requirements must be met:

- *Currently in High School or older
- *Physically able to participate in the installation
- *Attend 1 of the informational meetings (dates and times announced in October)
- *Submit a completed application to the church office no later than Tuesday, Dec. 31, 2019
- *Attend "Next Steps-Step 5" class "On Mission" which is 2 sessions, usually in June


