For six years Bruce McKanna faithfully served alongside Tracy as the Associate Pastor of the Evangelical Free Church of Mount Morris in Illinois. During those years Bruce and his wife Katie were blessed with two sons, Jack and Andrew, both teenagers now.

After God called us to Zambia in 2008, Bruce ministered as the church's interim pastor until he became their Senior Pastor in September of that same year. The church has continued to flourish under his leadership and we have watched with joy as he has grown in that role.

This September Bruce and Katie have returned to Zambia to join us in serving the APC pastors and their wives. For two weeks Bruce, Tracy, and our national lecturers will take the pastors on a journey to discover the rich history of Christian doctrine. Katie arrives on the 9th to partner with Karen as they visit the wives and host a women's retreat, the theme being "He Cares for Us." We have learned the value of teamwork, and we are looking forward to being together in ministry again.

Three APC students have died since its inception in 2008. The day before graduation in 2011, Frances Ng'andwe went home to be with the Lord after sustaining injuries in a head-on car crash.

This present class of 2020 has two empty seats now in the classroom. Apson Musonda died suddenly after being diagnosed with liver cancer in March. Further grief was compounded in June when we learned of the sudden death of Tresford Enga-Enga after Tracy returned home. Please be in prayer for their wives—Africa is not always kind to its widows. Pray for God to be their husbands, and for grace.
