Charles is busy with a number of projects running at the same time. November the translation team met and were able to finish the first draft of the revision of the book of Acts. In December, Samuel traveled and so Adriano and Charles worked on the dictionary in the mornings and back translations in the afternoon. When Adriano traveled to his home village for Christmas, Charles continued on with the interlinear for the revision of Luke. He was able to run after roofing for a new church building going up in the village of Makara. He did pulpit supply in our local church and a Wapishana church, filling in for a colleague on furlough.

This month he also spent a number of hours with a young intern explaining the process of translation, checking, back translation and interlinear. Five Bible school students from Word of Life spent about six weeks here visiting the various posts and getting a feel for ministry among indigenous peoples.

In February Charles will be taking a short trip to Southern Brazil to spend time with his 90-year-old mother. He calls her daily to check on her. Ministering to our family is important to us and not always easily accomplished from so many miles away. We started getting up at 5:30 every morning to spend about 45 minutes in prayer together. That has also become an important part of our ministry.

As mission hostess for the Brazilian mission board, MEVA, under which we also serve, I had the privilege and responsibility of providing housing for 245 guests in 2019. There was also a lot of baking, cleaning, and overall maintenance for the 12 furnished apartments. But there were also opportunities for discipleship. It was a joy to work with some special young ladies through a Conversational English class. I was also one of the speakers for a Titus 2 conference in November.

It was very nice to be in a teaching role again. An interest has been expressed in having me teach a women's course that I developed several years ago when we were at Word of Life. So, I've dusted that off and added and subtracted material in order to make it more applicable for use in the local church.

Charles and I revised our marriage and family course to use in premarital counseling with a young couple. Our time with them has been very sweet.
