The Heart Challenge

I've been struck by the references to the heart in the gospel of Mark during my recent quiet time reading. The word heart in the Bible is generally used to refer to the physical, emotional, and spiritual center of a person's life.

In Mark chapter six Jesus came walking on the water to the disciples, who were struggling against a storm in their boat. After He got into the boat and calmed the storm, the disciples were astonished. Verse 52 says, "for they had not gained any insight from the *incident of* the loaves, but their heart was hardened." (*Mark 6:52, NASB*). They weren't grasping His deity, which was being shown by the miracles He was doing.

In Mark chapter eight, Jesus warns the disciples about the leaven of the Pharisees and Herod. They think He's talking about bread, "And Jesus, aware of this, *said to them, "Why do you discuss the fact that you have no bread? Do you not yet see or understand? Do you have a hardened heart?" (Mark 8:17). Again, the rebuke reflects spiritual insensitivity, this time to what He is teaching them about the example and influence of the Pharisees and Herod.

What does it mean to have a "hard heart"? I think it is when the truth God is trying to communicate to us "bounces off" us, like the seed sown beside the road in the sower and the seed parable (*Mark 4:15*). The truth about who Jesus was, and the truth about the character of the Pharisees and Herod, wasn't being taken in. This made me wonder how often I fail to grasp a truth that the Lord is trying to convey to me, whether in something He's showing me, or something He's trying to tell me.

This also makes me wonder how a person's heart gets hardened. Notice what Jesus said about the Pharisees between the chapter six and chapter eight rebukes of the disciples, "And He said to them, "Rightly did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written: 'THIS PEOPLE HONORS ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR AWAY FROM ME." (Mark 7:6). Jesus identified the Pharisees as men who were hypocrites and whose hearts were "far away" from God. Later in the chapter He addresses legalism by telling them it isn't food that defiles a person because it doesn't go into the heart (verses 18-23). Herod would be an example of the other end of the spectrum, his indulgent, immoral, materialistic, and profane life was, in a word, worldly. Religious hypocrisy, legalism, and worldliness, surely have a heart hardening effect on our spiritual sensitivity. How many other sources pound us with messages that harden us?

When I consider the nature of my heart as revealed in God's Word, "The heart is more deceitful than all else And is desperately sick; Who can understand it?" (*Jeremiah 17:9*), I realize I need God's help! I'm thankful that ultimately it doesn't come down to reforming ourselves, but that we can go to God in humility saying, "Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me." (*Psalm 51:10*). I'm grateful that Jesus has provided for the forgiveness of our sins, and given us both new life, and His Word to help us see what's in our hearts.

The writer of Proverbs gave good practical advice, "Watch over your heart with all diligence, For from it *flow* the springs of life." (*Proverbs 4:23*). Some translations use the word "guard" for watch over. Can we help one another to be diligent to guard what we allow to come at our hearts?

Pray Daily


Often people make New Years resolutions but have difficulty keeping them.






