Who is Jesus revealed to be at His birth, by His first followers, and who will He be revealed to be one day? (Luke 2:11; 1 Cor.8:6; Philippians 2:11)

What does it mean to believe this is true of Jesus and know Him in this way?

Do you? Explain.

- 3. Notice how strongly Jesus felt about God's House in Matthew 21:12-13. Do you think the things done at our church reflect the Lord's desire for His house? Could it be better? Explain.
- 4. What is the amazing promise Jesus makes to His disciples in Matthew 21:21-22. How does one pray and not doubt?
- 5. In Matthew 21:23-44 Jesus faces a trap by Israel's leaders, then tells 2 parables. How does He expose their hypocrisy? What does He tell them the result will be?
