#### Tracy & Karen Singleton ACTION - Zambia

When we are asked how our trip to Zambia went, we often use the term, "our steps were bathed in butter." Taken from Job 29:6, this figurative phrase describes the abundance we felt at God's provision. It also fueled our hope that God would richly pave the way for Tracy's latest trip.

He was joined by John Farren, a former missionary and pastor from the UK. During the sessions in February and now March, these men and our Zambian partners will be tackling several important topics, including perseverance/assurance of the saints, spiritual warfare, and evangelism/missions.

There are many warnings in the Bible, particularly in the book of Hebrews, about perseverance. The lecturers will share four possible responses to these warnings—most of the pastors hold the view that a believer can lose his salvation, even after committing one serious sin. The view taught in APC is that perseverance in faith is necessary; warnings are to encourage believers to endure; and there are real consequences for not enduring in the Christian faith, but the promises of God are to be believed, and God is the One who keeps his children persevering.

During the first week of class the practices of the Lord's Supper and Believer's Baptism were discussed and studied. Zambians are challenged to faithfully keep these ordinances, in part, due to the cost of the elements, but also due to lack of baptismal facilities. Pray that the pastors will catch the vision to implement these celebrations in their churches.

Another topic, and one that is more "in your face" is that of spiritual warfare. The demonic is more overt in Zambia, and people are engaged in spiritism, often bringing this baggage to the Christian life. Deliverance is an aspect of NT ministry, but there is an imbalance in understanding that spiritual warfare also includes the struggle against the flesh and the world.

At the heart of African churches are a strong desire and motivation to carry out the Great Commission. Zambians are great witnesses and church planters for Christ. However, there is the need to go deeper into the Bible for understanding and the practice of missions and evangelism. Church leaders have been careless in handling the Scriptures when it comes to a biblical theology of missions, resulting in unhealthiness, error, and a weakness of the Gospel.

It is our hope that March's lectures on this subject will equip the pastors to make adjustments in their beliefs and practices regarding missions and evangelism.

Praise – For safe and convenient lodgings while in Zambia. For God's abundant provision for APC in the coming year!

Prayer – For God's blessing as Tracy & John lecture and for unity among the pastors as they think through critical issues. For safety and good health.
