Why is it important that in heaven it will be you in your body, and yet that your body will be transformed? How is this encouraging to you?

3. Read 1 Corinthians 15:50-57. When will our bodies be transformed and why? (v. 50-53)

What victory will then be accomplished? (v. 54-57)

List some of the things you most appreciate that will be gone.

4. What responses to the glorious truth of the coming resurrection are seen in verse 58?

How does, or can, knowing you will be resurrected into a body like this help you in times of disappointment, failure, or hardship?

How does, or can, knowing you will be resurrected into a body like this help you in choosing priorities, finding joy, and persevering in ministry?
