Child Protection Training Required – Don’t wait! For most of you, your child protection certifications are expiring in the next two months. Monroe Bible Church requires annual certification training for everyone who works with youth in any capacity, with background checks done every four years on adults. Now is the time to contact the church office (office@monroebiblechurch.org) with the email address you would like to use in order to complete your annual training. Once you’ve contacted the office you will receive an email from Mobilize My Ministry requesting information, then another email with a link to complete your training online. The training consists of a video followed by a quiz, and takes about 45 minutes to complete. The office is notified once you’ve successfully completed your training. Be sure to check your Spam folders if you don’t see the email you’re expecting. Once your training online is completed, you will then need to read and sign the **MBC Policy & Rules for Child Protection Certification**. You can pick that form up from your ministry leader or the office, or the office can email it to you. Sign it and return it back to the office.
