Resonate Church, Janesville

God is doing some great work here, and there's no doubt it's because of faithful prayer partners like you. One of the important goals, for both Resonate Church and MBC, is to continue developing this partnership. I wanted to share some ways God has been showing his face and light in recent months.

One thing I was not prepared for in church planting training, was planning and growing a church/people during a national pandemic. Like most other churches, we have prayerfully asked God to not just intervene, but to move in this time of desperation, vulnerability, and fear. God has truly moved in some pretty substantial ways. We had a Resurrection Celebration Service on Easter Sunday. We partnered with another small church in town and opened up our parking lot for a "Drive-In Worship Service". God did some pretty miraculous things during this service. 1) the weather forecast looked gloomy and uncooperative the whole week. I prayed and remained confident that God had big plans. God showed up – it was sunny and mid-60s! 2) normally we average around 85-90 people on a Sunday morning, the church partnering with us averages 60. When we opened up our parking lot, we counted 74 cars, plus neighbors listening in, and people walking by and joining us in the grass. It was estimated that we had 350 people at the service! 3) because it went so well, our leadership team decided to have two more "Drive-In Worship Services", then a church "Picnic Service" on May 31st. It was amazing! I had the privilege of going and inviting our neighbors to that service. Five more houses joined us for our services! I got to pray with two of them, including a man going through cancer that was overjoyed with my visit and prayer.

Our media/online community has been growing as well. It has been exciting to see other churches partner with us, church members/attenders holding "watch parties", or community people that we don't see at church very often join us for our Social Media Services. Pray with us that these people who have joined us via media, or for our outdoor services, see the need and desire to come join our church family!

I continue to build a close relationship with the fire chief here in town. We are attempting to plan a celebration and presentation to our church of me becoming the Janesville Fire Department Chaplain in the next month or so. God has not just opened a window, he swung open the door! Please keep praying for this.

We are excited to be planning our "Re-Open the Building" service with baptisms. Currently we have 4 baptisms planned, including a young man that said "yes" to building his life & marriage on Jesus while we were doing pre-marriage counseling. My daughter Mariana is also getting baptized!

Thank you again for your partnership. I truly appreciate all of you, your church, your generosity, and love to us. We are so thankful God has gifted us with such amazing people and we couldn't be doing this without you! I am humbled at what God has done in our partnership and I pray he continues to nurture it.
