## Pastor's Pen:

### Within and Without



It's discouraging. We've seen another COVID-19 spike and the governor has extended the face covering order. The COVID-19 related death toll continues to climb, people are without work, people are losing the businesses they've worked hard and taken great risk to establish, families are divided, and churches are struggling. I've read that pollsters are estimating that 20% of our churches will not reopen, 20% of those watching church online won't ever return to a church in person, and many pastors will quit because of the stress. Police are under attack and many are quitting, riots break out in our streets, politics are as rancorous as ever, and people say they believe the science but have different conclusions. This is why I love the current posting on our highway sign, "If you're going to believe everything you read, start with the Bible."

So, I keep reminding myself, "you have need of endurance" (Hebrews 10:36). I remind myself that God hasn't changed (Malachi 3:6), He is still sovereign and hasn't turned over His throne to anyone else (Daniel 4:35), and that His will is still "good, acceptable, and perfect" (Romans 12:2). The gift of eternal life has not been withdrawn, its fulness is closer than ever, and the indwelling Holy Spirit has not been removed from His people. There are many more encouraging truths we can find in God's Word, so I need to stay there.

One of the things that hasn't changed is our mission – build the Lord's church by making disciples. There is a "within" aspect and a "without" aspect, neither of which we dare overlook. The "within" challenge is the same as it has always been, differences exist among the people in the church. Jews and Gentiles, rich and poor, different nationalities, political affiliation, etc. are just a few of the differences. While those differences can destroy a church, they can also be the very thing that strengthens it. Churches that stress conformity in everything are seldom effective in reaching those outside their walls. Churches that learn to build unity with their differences become stronger and their testimony more powerful in the community. The key to building unity with differences is to **emphasize the essential**. The reformers identified these essentials: Sola scriptura ("by Scripture alone"), Sola fide ("by faith alone"), Sola gratia ("by grace alone"), Solus Christus or Solo Christo ("Christ alone" or "through Christ alone"), and Soli Deo gloria ("glory to God alone").

The "without" challenge is giving the gospel. We cannot make disciples and build the Lord's church from among outsiders unless we give the gospel. Obviously, this means the gospel message, but it also means the gospel in life. We are now in what is called a "cancel culture." It means those who disagree with you, "cancel" you. They unfriend or delete you in social media, or invalidate you and your opinion however they can. This presents a great challenge to helping someone understand that they are a sinner, an essential understanding in the gospel message. The apostle Paul's words, "I have become all things to all men, so that I may by all means save some" (1 Corinthians 9:22, NASB), are SO relevant today! What was he talking about? Respecting the beliefs of others, without necessarily agreeing with them, in order to have conversation with them. It is knowing that come judgment day, the only thing that really matters is whether anyone is right or wrong concerning the gospel of Christ.

In addition to respect, is the issue of love. Jesus made it clear that His followers are to be known by their love for one another (John 13:35), and to love even their enemies (Matthew 5:44). People are far more ready to listen to someone who has shown them **compassion and respect**, especially when they also see other evidences of Jesus living within.

If we emphasize the essential with compassion and respect, and stay intentional at the mission Christ has called us to, I think these discouraging days can be encouraging days!


