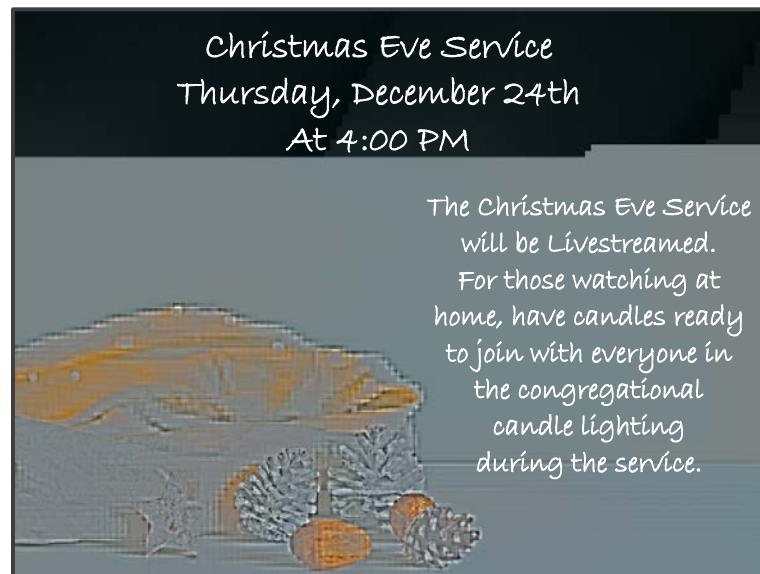

New Pipeline Series Begins Today

Today’s teens are juggling and navigating through a culture in crisis. They are in need of wise parenting, counseling and authentic support. Since the start of 2020 many of our families have been pressured almost overnight to change the ways we do life, school, even interact with friends and teachers, all online.

Schoolwork is no longer the same. Tests are taken through a screen, assignments turned in by the click of a button, and conversations are hidden in an email or some online form of messaging.

With the use of computers and cell phones has come the ease of access to information & material, which is not always good. It’s been stated that 70% of young men have seen pornography online by accident. The problem with being online so much is that accidents don’t remain accidents and porn becomes one of the reasons young men and women are getting online.

We believe that our high school students need to be equipped with resources to navigate our modern culture. Parents and children are online and making choices about what they will “click” on and what to avoid. I’m inviting our parents and other caring adults to join us for a 6-week series in the Pipeline class at 9 am Sunday mornings in the Nehemiah Center called “A Parent’s Guide to Talking with Boys/Girls about Porn”. We will be using Axis, an online Christ-centered resource for parents and youth leaders who wish to keep their finger on the pulse of the shifting culture through written, video, and audio-based material.

Our High School Only discussion will be on Sunday Nights from 6-8 pm and will be material from the same resource. Copies of the student outline/discussion notes will be provided at Pipeline for our parents.

Please consider joining us for the 9 am Pipeline series and encourage your High School student to attend Fusion Sunday nights.
