Pastor's Pen:

Inventories and Reports

As 2020 came to a close it meant taking inventory and making reports at work for some people. Some of us may do this, in a way, with our personal lives as well. Something related to inventories and reports struck me as I was following our Bible reading plan.



You're probably familiar with the account of Jesus and the demoniac who lived among the tombs. Jesus and His disciples had sailed to the eastern shore of the Sea of Galilee, into the Gentile area known as the country of the Gerasenes. This man lived among the tombs, prowled about naked, and would often cut himself. He would be bound with chains and shackles and put under guard, but when a demon would seize control, he would break free and flee into the desert. As we would expect, the townspeople feared him. When Jesus came into the area and commanded the demons to leave this man, he falls down before Him, and loudly cries out, "What business do we have with each other, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg You, do not torment me." (Luke 8:28, NASB). The demons ask Jesus not to send them to the abyss and beg to be sent into the swine nearby. The account then simply reads, "And He gave them permission." (verse 32). So little effort on the part of Jesus.

Someone asked me recently if I thought there were demons around since they seemed so common in Biblical times. Another expressed concern about opening ourselves up to demons. Well, I do think they are around. While I don't think new ones are coming into existence, unless they've been sent to the abyss, there's no reason to think they wouldn't be actively doing Satan's work. And, as our nation continues to turn its back on God, we are giving them more opportunity to work here. But we ought not to fear them. For though the demons in this man called themselves "Legion" because there were so many in him, Jesus had no difficulty dealing with them.

The part that struck me as I was reading was the man, after he was freed from the demons. He begged Jesus to go with Him. Jesus said no, but to go to his home and, "describe what great things God has done for you." (Luke 8:39). It's the second part of the verse that caught my attention, "So he went away, proclaiming throughout the whole city what great things Jesus had done for him." Notice that it wasn't the great thing Jesus did, as in casting out the demons, but "great things," plural. What else had Jesus done for him? Nothing is recorded. Perhaps some of the "things" were different miseries he was now set free from, or new opportunities he had for his life.

It made me ask myself, "Are there not great things the Lord has done for me that I can tell people?" It made me realize that I don't often take inventory. How about you? Peter wrote, "but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence;" (1 Peter 3:15). Notice, "always being ready" and "an account for the hope that is in you." Could you make a list of things the Lord delivered you from? Could you list some wonderful things you now have because of Him? I wonder if we wouldn't begin to see more and more opportunities to "proclaim what great things Jesus has done for us," if we were looking and ready?

The silver lining in the dark cloud of 2020 is the opportunity it has created. Many are fatigued and discouraged, but looking for hope and willing to talk about eternity. Many of us are tired and discouraged as well. Can we begin the New Year by taking an inventory, and look for opportunities to "report" it to others?

Monroe Bible Church Directory

Do you have our Church Directory? Are you in it? Our church directory is online and only people from our congregation can access our directory. You can view the directory from your computer or a smart phone, whichever you prefer. You can also print out a hard copy to use.

Many who have Instant Church Directory have commented how great it is to use. Did you know that you when you access our Instant Church Directory through the App on your phone you can call, text, or email someone in the congregation directly through the App? It's that convenient and easy to use!



Do you recognize the person sitting next to you in church? Do they recognize you? Most of us use the directory for contact information, but it can also be used for putting a name with a face.

Many of our members and regular attenders did not get their pictures included in the directory. It's easy to submit a picture into the online directory! This time of year, families often get a nice picture taken for sending out Christmas cards or while at family gatherings, so this is a great time for you to submit a picture. Remember pictures in the directory are only about 1 ½" squared, so sit side-by-side, or make sure your family takes a "stacked" photo with young children in front and adults behind them, or adults sitting in front and older children standing behind their parents. You can upload the picture to the directory yourself, or you can send a jpeg image to the church office and we'll do it for you.

Contact the church office if you would like to be included in the directory or if you need directions to set up access.
