Pastor's Pen:

Imagine

If you are following our Bible reading plan as I am, you've been in the book of Acts for two plus weeks. With each day's reading I've wondered what it would have been like to have been there. Miraculous things were happening. The first followers, gathered

together in a house, are suddenly filled with the Holy Spirit and begin speaking "of the mighty deeds of God" (Acts 2:11, *NASB*) in some of the numerous languages of people in Jerusalem for Pentecost. Peter preaches to the crowd, "and that day there were added about three thousand souls" (Acts 2:41). Peter heals a lame man who then enters the temple "walking and leaping and praising God" and the people "were filled with wonder and amazement" (Acts 3:8, 10). Peter preaches again, a call to repentance, the people respond, and, "the number of the men came to be about five thousand" (Acts 4:4).

The account continues, "At the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were taking place among the people...the people held them in high esteem.¹⁴ And all the more believers in the Lord, multitudes of men and women, were constantly added to *their number* (Acts 5:12–14). Imagine this, "The word of God kept on spreading; and the number of the disciples continued to increase greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many <u>of the priests</u> were becoming obedient to the faith." (Acts 6:7). How exciting a time to be a believer!

However, it was not without hardships. Peter and John were thrown in jail, then brought before Israel's rulers, scribes, and high priests for interrogation, and threatened before being released. (Acts 4:3-7). Then, it happened again, and this time they were flogged before being released (Acts 5:17-40). The thought of being in <u>their</u> shoes isn't as appealing! Stephen is stoned (Acts 7) and Saul begins ravaging the church (Acts 8). As the church begins to spread out, they do so "preaching the word" (Acts 8:4) and the church continues to grow.

Acts 2:46 says, "Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart." Acts 5:42 says, "And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they kept right on teaching and preaching Jesus *as* the Christ." Many were selling property and possessions to help meet the needs of others (Acts 2:45; 4:32-34). How sweet the time must have been when the believers were together! This record of the early church made me wonder if we aren't missing something, something good for both us as believers, and for our witness.

In the December newsletter of Pinnacle Ministries this statement was made, "Where is the groundswell of, 'Seize the moment!' in the church?" That resonated with me because I've tried to see our current circumstances as an opportunity rather than a season to just endure (grumbling and complaining). I asked myself, "How do we equip our church to seize the moment?" What are the questions people in the community are asking, or statements they are making, that are actually our windows of opportunity? Imagine what might happen if we each gave some thought, prayer, and a little preparation time to making ourselves ready to respond! (1 Peter 3:15)

One of the Hispanic brothers gave me a mug as an appreciation gift on Sunday. It said, "A leader knows how to transform problems into opportunities." It reinvigorated me to help us look for the opportunities, and strive to seize the moment. Imagine what might happen if we all prioritized preparing ourselves to respond, and to encouraging one another!


