Revealed by His Resurrection

I. The Sobering Message (Acts 17:31)

The resurrection of Jesus proved that <u>He</u> is the <u>One</u> through whom God will <u>judge</u> the <u>world</u>.

II. The Provision Message (Romans 1:4)

The resurrection of Jesus proved that He was the <u>Son</u> of <u>God</u>, the promised <u>good news</u> to the world.

III. The Hope-Giving Message (Romans 4:25)

The resurrection of Jesus proved that even though we have <u>sinned</u>, we could be given a <u>righteous standing</u> before God.

4. Read Romans 1:1-6. How does Paul identify himself, his purpose, and his message?

What significant thing does he say the resurrection of Jesus revealed? Why is this important to the message he gives?

In what way does knowing Jesus is the Son of God make the gospel message more powerful in your life?

- 5. Read Romans 4:1-8. What was credited to Abraham? On what basis? What does that mean?
- 6. Read Romans 4:16. What 2 reasons are given for the importance of righteousness coming through faith?
- 7. Read Romans 4:23-25. What was Jesus delivered to and raised to? Why?
