

When Will It End?

The news stories continue, another tragic school shooting, war atrocities in Ukraine, violence and threats in response to a Supreme Court ruling that hasn't even been released. The "Woke" movement, Critical Race Theory, gender confusion, it all points to a problem that governments and education cannot fix. We'll be looking at the beginning of that problem in our new series, "So Great a Salvation." I saw Jesus pointing out the source of the problem in my devotional readings in Mark the last couple of days.



Jesus sent the disciples across the Sea of Galilee in a boat while He went up the mountain to pray. He came walking on the water by them late in the night and they were "utterly astonished" when He then calmed the storm for them. Then verse 52 says, "for they had not gained any insight from the incident of the loaves, but their heart was hardened." (Mark 6:52, *NASB95*). Their heart was "hardened." Their spiritual sensitivity to see what Jesus was revealing about Himself wasn't working.

In the next chapter, some Pharisees and scribes question Jesus as to why His disciples aren't walking according to the traditions of the elders (ceremonially washing their hands before eating). "And He said to them, 'Rightly did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written: 'THIS PEOPLE HONORS ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR AWAY FROM ME.'" (Mark 7:6). Again, we see a heart problem. Jesus then explains to His disciples, "And He was saying, 'That which proceeds out of the man, that is what defiles the man.'" (Mark 7:20). Jesus goes on to give examples of sin that proceeds out of a person, such as fornications, thefts, coveting, slander, pride, and foolishness (verses 21-22). Yes, foolishness! Again, we see that the problem begins in the heart.

In James we saw what happens when sin is not checked at the heart level – "But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust. ¹⁵ Then when lust has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and when sin is accomplished, it brings forth death." (James 1:14–15). Temptations will appeal to heart lusts, and if allowed to germinate, carry a person away into sin. The potential is in every human being.

Sadly, it's hard to expect things to get better while our nation and world continue to reject God's explanation of sin. No amount of education, legislation, or punishment, while each has its place, will keep sin from taking control in people when there is no belief in God. While it's difficult to watch the growing tide of painful consequences, let's be careful not to simply complain about the evil, or to point to mere human solutions. The need is for a new heart.

In Jeremiah 31 and Ezekiel 36, God promises a future restoration of the Jewish people to their land and their God. "Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷ I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances." (Ezekiel 36:26–27). The coming of Christ and provision of new life (John 3:3, 5; and 2 Corinthians 5:17) brought the opportunity for a new heart.

Granted, the problems are complex and multifaceted. It is bigger than you or I can fix. It won't end in our lifetime. But we have opportunity to point the growing number of people, plagued by confusion, fear, and anxiety, to the reason, and to the solution, for our rapidly digressing world. And who knows, perhaps that one troubled person looking for hope and meaning that you might lead to Christ, is the one who would otherwise commit an atrocity! Let's be faithful to speak the truth in love, as we point people to the universal need of all people.




Child Protection Training
