I. What Did Jesus Say? (John 3:16-18)

II. What Did the Disciples Say? (John 1:10-13; 1 Peter 1:8-9)

Warm up question: What are the most common reasons you hear people give for thinking they will go to heaven?

1. Read the following verses in John's gospel. What does Jesus say about what a person must do to be saved? (John 3:16-18, 36; 6:28-29, 40)

Explain what doing this means.

What does being saved mean?

2. What did Jesus say about repentance in Matthew 4:17; Mark 1:15; and Luke 5:32; 24:45-47). What does repentance mean?

Does it have anything to do with gaining salvation?

3. What did the disciples John and Peter say about how to be saved? (John 1:10-13; 1 Peter 1:8-9; 2: 6-7)

Did Peter say repentance is required for salvation, for everyone? (Acts 2:37-38; 2 Peter 3:9) Explain.

4. What did the apostles Paul and James say about how to be saved? (Ephesians 2:8-9; Acts 16:30-31; Romans 10:9-10; James 2:14)

Did the apostles teach that repentance was necessary for salvation? (Acts 20:20-21; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Timothy 2:25; Hebrews 6:1) Explain.

5. What would you say to the person who used Acts 2:38 and 1 Peter 3:21 to say that salvation is by baptism?
