Now What?

I. Sanctification (John 17:17; Hebrews 12:14)

After saving me, God's work in me, and will for me, is for a *holy* life.

II. Perseverance (Philippians 1:6; 2:13; James 1:12)

After saving me, God's work in me, and will for me, is for an *enduring* faith.

III. Glorification (1 Peter 4:11; 1 Corinthians 10:31)

After saving me, God's work in me, and will for me, is that I *glorify* Him in *everything*.

<u>Application Questions</u> - These questions are provided for your further study and application of the subject of today's message. Thoughtfully writing out answers to these questions will help drive home the point. They are designed to be discussed in your home, with other believers, and in a Life Group for even more benefit.

Warm up question: Can you think of an example of doing something special for someone, in hopes of seeing a good response in them? What happened?

1. God's will for those He saves is that they live holy lives. Read John 17:17; Hebrews 12:14; and 1 Thessalonians 4:3-7. Define a holy life and give examples of what it would look like.

How might those who try to live holy lives draw, or turn off, people to the Lord and to His church?

2. God's will for those He saves is that they persevere in their faith. Read Philippians 1:6, 2:13; James 1:12; and Romans 5:3-5. Does a persevering faith mean never sin, or never sin badly? Explain.

How does God help one persevere in their faith?

3. God's will for those He saves is that their lives glorify Him. Why? Read 1 Peter 4:11; 1 Corinthians 10:31; and Romans 11:33-36.

How do we bring glory to God?

4. God does an incredible amount for us, not only in bringing us to saving faith, but also in our lives after conversion. What is the place of works in all of this?
