Growing in Grace

I. Granted Everything (1-4)

God has given you all you need to live a *godly* life through *knowing Christ*.

II. Growing Effectiveness (5-9)

So, *apply yourself* to the virtues that come from *knowing* Christ!

III. Glorious Entry (10-11)

The virtues that come from knowing Christ become measures for our <u>assurance</u> of faith, and our eternal <u>reward</u>.

Warm up: What kinds of thoughts come to mind when you think of someone being a godly person? Why do these thoughts come to mind?

1. Read 2 Peter 1:1-4.

What stands out to you about God and about yourself in Peter's opening greeting? (v. 1-2)

What words does Peter use to describe God? What does he say God did, and why?

This section should encourage us to live godly lives. What encouragement do you see that encourages you? What are some of your more challenging obstacles to living a godly life?

2. Read 2 Peter 1:5-9.

Notice the virtues that Peter identifies as what his readers should be diligent to apply themselves to live out. Which 1 or 2 do you most need to "increase" in your life?

What motivation(s) to "apply yourself" do you see in this section?

3. Read 2 Peter 1:10-11.

Peter urges his readers again to be diligent. What is he urging them to apply themselves to, and why?

4. What is your takeaway application from this passage?
