A Light to Your Path

I. Teach It (12-15)

We need to be taught and reminded of doctrine so that we live it.

II. Trust It (16-18)

Our doctrine about Christ can be trusted because it <u>came</u> from <u>God</u> and through <u>eyewitnesses</u>.

III. Take It to Heart (19-21)

We should *follow* what Scripture says because it has *come* from *God*.

2. Read 2 Peter 1:16-18. What did Peter want his readers to know? Why could they know?

What are some important doctrines about Christ every believer should know, and why are they important?

Why would these doctrines be hard for one who is not yet a believer to believe they are true? How would you try to help them believe?

3. Read 2 Peter 1:19-21. What did Peter assure his readers? What purpose would be served in assuring them of this?

If this is true, how should it affect our thinking about the Bible?

4. What's one application you can make from this passage?
