What do they willingly overlook? What do they fail to consider?

What are some of the messages we hear from the world, and/or scoffers, today? What is God's truth that those messages contradict?

3. What 2 reasons does Peter give his readers in 2 Peter 3:8-9 for why we shouldn't be upset that the Lord hasn't returned yet?

4. What 2 things does Peter tell his readers will happen in 2 Peter 3:10?

Why should these things affect how we live today?

Is there a change that you think God would like you to make in your life in response to what you read in this passage? Explain.
