Worship: A Discipline?

I. What is Worship?

Worship is a *reverent* and *honoring* response to the *perceived* presence of God.

Worship can be the response to *joyful*, *thankful*, and *heartbreaking* life experiences.

Worship is both a *private* and a *corporate* response to the presence of God.

II. How Should We Worship?

Acceptable worship is acts of *sacrifice* that honor God with our *inner spirit* and *outer body*, and is guided by God's *truth* and *Spirit*.
