The First Testimony

I. The Expectation (1-4)

The women went to the tomb *expecting* to anoint the *dead* body of Jesus.

II. The Encounter (5-7)

The women <u>saw</u> the empty tomb and <u>heard</u> from an angel that Jesus had <u>risen</u> from the dead.

III. The Emotion (8)

The response of the women to what they *witnessed* gave strong *testimony* to the truthfulness of the resurrection of Jesus.

1. What is the best, and worst, experience you had for Easter? Why?

What effect does knowing Jesus died have on your life?

3. From Mark 16:5-7, what did the women see? What were they told?

Think about how important hearing and reading this would have been to the early disciples. Why is having this account valuable to you?

4. Mark 16:8 says the women were afraid. Why might they have been afraid?

What purpose does recording their fear serve?

5. What is the message of this passage and why is it valuable to you?

What are some of the responses you could or should have to this message?
