The Starting Point

Jesus called us on a mission to make disciples (Matthew 28:19). We talk about making disciples, but for some this term can be filled with ambiguity. At its core, discipleship is forming relationships with people that can then be used to introduce them to Jesus Christ, resulting in a saving faith that can be mutually strengthened as you continue to follow Jesus. These relationships all start with a conversation. The thought of starting a spiritual conversation can be filled with trepidation and a sense of not knowing where or how to start. In my line of work, I talk with people all day. While not all conversations are of a spiritual nature, I would like to share a few conversation starters that have worked for me. These are simple questions or topics that can be steered to a spiritual conversation and ultimately Jesus and what He has done for me.

Do you have weekend plans? People usually reciprocate the question back to you after they have told you their plans. Among other things, you could mention church on Sunday and ask if they attend somewhere. This could turn into an invite or why you feel at home at MBC. The benefits and importance of belonging to a community of faith centered on Jesus and the Word of God could be mentioned.

Any comments on the decline of our culture, the disregard for the sanctity of life, chaos, etc, could be used. You could comment that the world didn't start this way. Creation was perfect, and all people are valued by God as beings created in His image (Gen 1:27). Sin and rebellion has led to the decline that we see today (Romans 1:28-32). The solution to this can be found in Jesus and His work on the cross to take the penalty of sin. He offers the free gift of life knowing Him as Lord!

Any comments on getting old, physical ailments, sickness or physical decline can be directed in the same way. We were not created this way, but sin resulted in death and decay in creation (Gen 3:19, Rom 5:12). While our bodies and nature will physically die, we can have assurance and hope of eternal life! Jesus paid the price for sin and offers the gift of eternal life without death and decay (Rev 21:4). Do you know Him? Do you want to?

Politics. Regardless of political party affiliation, all humans are flawed, selfish, and mainly look to further advance themselves. You could explain how we can't place our hope in mortal man to solve our problems (Prov 11:7). My hope is in Jesus who will one day set all things right! (Rev 21:4-5)

Not everyone will respond kindly and will make it obvious that they do not want to speak about such matters. Others may just seem disinterested or politely decline to discuss further. Just humbly move on, knowing that at least you have planted a seed. My hope is that this will be helpful in turning everyday conversions to spiritual ones and the process of discipleship can begin.

Let the words of Colossians 4:5-6 be your guide as you seek to have these conversations: "Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders, make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation always be full of grace and seasoned with salt so that you may know how to answer everyone."

The meals are likely bound for Zambia, where our retired missionaries Tracy and Karen Singleton served and still are involved in the training of pastors through Action Pastors College. Hope E. Free Church joined us by donating funds and helping pack meals. Thanks to all who helped provide food and the Good News to many in need.

If you haven't taken a baby bottle home to collect spare change for the Care Net Pregnancy Center, do so soon! The fundraiser ends on Fathers' Day. After June 18th you can still donate by dropping your baby bottle (or check) at the Center. They are hoping to be especially blessed with funding this year, as they set up ultrasound equipment and training to expand services for their clientele.

Thank you for your very generous financial support for the Guatemala mission team serving this month from the 10th to the 17th. They hope to share daily prayer requests and praises so that you can pray for them specifically, as they work on construction of the Retreat and Training Center during the day, and evenings go in small groups into Guatemalan homes to encourage and pray for their needs. Child Protection Training Required

MBC requires annual child protection training certification for everyone working with youth. Background checks and training are done online through Protect My Ministry.

The Child Protection Training is a 3-Part Process:

Background Check (required every 4 years for all adults)

Training Video & Quiz (takes about 45 minutes to complete)

Read, Sign, & Return the MBC Policy & Rules for Child Protection

Begin the process by contacting the church office with the email address you would like to use to complete your online training.

You'll receive an email from message@mobilizemyministry.com with links to complete the background check and your child protection training video with quiz.

*Be sure to check your Spam folders if you don't see the email you're expecting. Don't wait, the email links do expire!

Get your training done before ministries begin!


