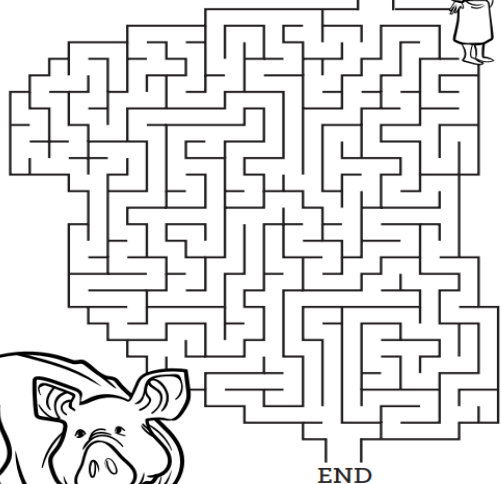
Jesus was so powerful that he could calm a storm with only the words, "Peace, Be Still." **Can you spot the 8 differences between these two pictures?**



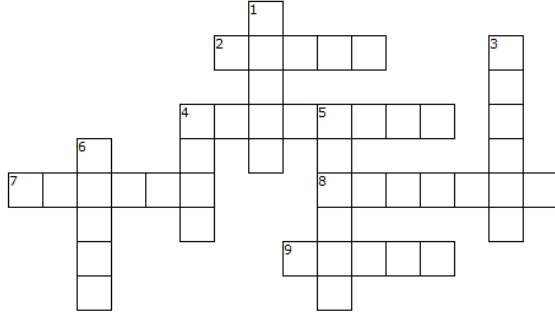


