# The Needed Strength

#### I. On the Lake (8:22-25)

Jesus demonstrated His power over *forces* of *nature*.

## II. In Gerasenes (8:26-39)

Jesus demonstrated His power over <u>demons</u>.

## III. Among the People (8:40-56)

Jesus demonstrated His power over death and disease.

## IV. In the Villages (9:1-10a)

Jesus demonstrated His power to <u>empower</u> His servants for ministry.

#### V. At Bethsaida (9:12-17)

Jesus demonstrated that <u>His</u> power was <u>available</u> to His servants for ministry.

<u>Application Questions</u> - These questions are provided for your further study and application of the subject of today's message. Thoughtfully writing out answers to these questions will help drive home the point. They are designed to be discussed in your home, with other believers, and in a Life Group for even more benefit.

- 1. In Luke 8:22-25 we see Jesus demonstrate His power over forces of nature. When and/or what kind of circumstances in your life might the storm illustrate? What can you believe about Jesus from this account?
- 2. What word would you use to describe the demoniac's condition before he met Jesus in Luke 8:26-39? After he met Jesus? What lesson for you is there in this?
- 3. Read Luke 8:40-56. Imagine that you were Jairus, then the hemorrhaging woman. What would have been difficult upon seeing Jesus in each case? What would you have learned about Him?
- 4. Read Luke 9:1-10a. What might Jesus have been trying to teach His disciples by sending them out? Is there a lesson for you in this?
- 5. What, more than feeding over 5,000 hungry people in Luke 9:12-17, would Jesus have been doing? In what way does this encourage you in your walk with Jesus?
