
Today's Reading: Luke 9:51-10:24

"The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few; ask the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into the field."



At the end of Luke 9, Jesus was traveling to his home town of Jerusalem when he was rejected from entering the town. Instead of punishing the town, He sent out 72 of His followers to go into every town and place where He was about to go.

Jesus told them "The harvest is plenty but the workers are few." This meant that there were a lot of people that had not heard about Him or the gospel. Also, there were not many people sharing the good news of Jesus and the gospel. He told His followers to take nothing with them and to prepare the way for Jesus by telling the people in these towns about Him.
