What Should I Fear?

I. Beware (1-12)

Fear *God's judgment* not *man's*.

II. Beware (13-21)

Be <u>rich</u> toward <u>God</u> not <u>self</u>.

III. Beware (22-34)

Focus on God's kingdom and He'll *take care* of yours.

Which form(s) tempt you most? Why?

3. What does Jesus tell His listeners not to do in Luke 12:22-28? Why, and what does He tell them to do instead?

What does Jesus also tell His listeners not to do in Luke 12:29-34? Why, and what does He tell them to do instead?

What helps you not to worry when worry begins to set in? What doesn't help?

What does, or could, seeking God's kingdom look like in your life?

4. What one thing do you think Jesus wants you to look to Him for help with from Luke 12:1-34? How will you get His help?
