## Today's Reading: Luke 15:1-32


## Today, at church I learned:

One day, Jesus was talking to a crowd of people. In that crowd were some Pharisees that were unhappy with Jesus for spending time with sinners. Jesus told three stories: the parable of the lost sheep, the lost coin, and the lost son. Each of these stories, shows us how God feels about lost things, specifically lost people - sinners.

The shepherd is looking for one specific sheep. It looks just like the one in his picture. Can you find it? When you do, circle it.


Cross out every other letter to reveal a hidden message. Write the message in the space below.
