Belong, Believe, Become

I. Belong (Romans1:6)

<u>Belong</u> – "The process of a Christ follower committing meaningful, intentional and consistent <u>time</u> to a person or a group of people so that they know who <u>Jesus</u> is and are <u>known</u> by a group of believers."

II. Believe (John 3:16)

<u>Believe</u> – "That is helping people place their <u>faith</u> in Jesus and <u>apply</u> God's <u>Word</u> to their life." <u>Application Questions</u> – These questions are provided for your further study and application of the subject of today's message. Thoughtfully writing out answers to these questions will help drive home the point. They are designed to be discussed in your home, with other believers, and in a Life Group for even more benefit.
