1. The distinctive feature and message of the book of Hosea is Whoredom.
  2. Our relationship with God is like a marriage.
    - a. Sin is spiritual adultery.
    - b. All people are Gomer.
  3. Jesus is faithful to the faithless.
  4. You cannot break the covenant of grace, because it is sealed with His blood, not yours!
1. God told Hosea to marry a prostitute. Describe a time you felt God tell you to do something that seemed ridiculous.
  2. The sermon briefly talked about the differences between the Old and the New Covenant. How would you describe them to someone new to the faith?
  3. The Bible frequently describes our relationship with God like a marriage. How does this contribute to your walk with the Lord?
  4. Hosea, at God’s command, went after his wife in the midst of her sin. Share about a time when you felt the Lord coming after you in the midst of your sin?
  5. How does it make you feel to be reminded that your relationship with God is not based on your faithfulness, but on His?
  6. In light of God’s ever-faithful love toward us, Hosea 14:1 invites us to “Return...to the Lord your God.” What is one way this week that you need to return to the Lord your God?
